**CELL PHONES/ELECTRONICS POLICY**

Do's	Don'ts
<p>Cell phones and Electronic devices <b>may be used</b> during students' designated lunchtime and dismissal ONLY.</p> <p>When cell phones are used, the volume on these devices should be kept at minimum level.</p>	<p>Cell phones and Electronic devices <b><u>may not be used</u></b> during school hours.</p> <p>Cell phones and Electronic used at prohibited times and location <b><u>will be confiscated</u></b>.</p> <p>Devices are not to be used in classroom unless teacher provides an academic purpose.</p> <p>Devices are not to be used during class period transitions.</p> <p>Any recording on video devices <b><u>are prohibited</u></b>.</p>

Failure to surrender an electronic device (including cell phones) constitutes Disobedience & Insubordination and will result in a consequence.

Note: Violation of this policy during the school day will result in confiscation of the device (released to a parent) and parent contact by the school.

The second time a student violates this policy; he/she will receive an additional discipline consequences (OSS, ISS or Lunch Detentions).

The third time a student violates this policy; he/she will be given a consequence (In-School Suspension or Out of School Suspension). Failure to serve consequences will result in additional interventions.

# BBCHS Cell Phone

(Wireless communication devices)



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**School Board Policy 5.183** allows students to possess wireless communication devices (including cell phones) on campus for use **before and after the school day and during students' designated lunchtime and dismissal.**

If students possess a cellular phone (or other wireless communications device), it should be turned off and kept inside a book bag, purse or similar container, and it may not be used (and may not be allowed to emit any ring tone or other noise).

Possession or use of a camera phone (communication device capable of taking digital photographs) on school grounds or during any school-sponsored program or activity, including school transportation, is prohibited and shall constitute "possession and/or use of items or contraband designated by the school as inappropriate materials" (**SB Policy 5.1813**) and consequences will be imposed accordingly.

**This policy includes:** Mp3 players (iPods), CD players, DVD players, digital video players, headphones, earbuds, cell phones, electronic games, (PSP), radios, laser pointers, and other items that are not conducive to a safe learning environment **are not allowed on campus for use during class or between classes. If seen or used they will be confiscate**
